Introducing the Parish Mission-Support Team

As the Business Manager, it has been a privilege to work with and support our Parish Priest Fr Greg Bellamy who has a vision to see our Catholic community healthy and growing. He is a priest who is taking our Catholic faith community on mission. In the Catholic Church of my youth, it was a given that everyone would attend Mass and the sacraments each weekend. We all know this has changed and our Parish is recognising this and responding.

It has also been a joy to work with Fr Pius. As an athletics enthusiast I have been fortunate to assist many athletes in the past, including two Kenyan athletes. Having this Kenyan connection, I was delighted to be able to greet Fr Pius in his native language. Fr Pius is compassionate and extremely generous with his time. He demonstrates a great commitment our parishioners, rushing out day or night to anyone who is sick or in their final hours to provide a blessing and the Eucharist.

Coming from the large single-church parish of John the Baptist in Bonnyrigg, Sydney, it was a shock to see how many churches were in our vast area of Orange and Molong. We are blessed to have so many dedicated parishioners who have supported and continue to support the parish with their financial offerings. This financial support is appreciated as the maintenance of the eight churches in our Parish is no mean feat. As you would appreciate, running this parish requires weekly, monthly and annual servicing and maintenance. I am fortunate to have two parish office staff, Sandy Livermore and Harriette Williams, who assist in the organisation of this maintenance and provide day to day contact to the parish and wider community. I thank them for their friendly, welcoming and committed service.

A key aspect of my role is to provide administrative and operational support to the priests of the Parish and the Mission Team and to support them with the resources to make more disciples.

Another of my key roles is to advise Fr Greg and manage parish finances together with the advice from the Parish Finance Councils, Orange and Molong. The members of these councils contribute their professional expertise and advice for the good management of our financial resources. We have introduced monthly budgeting and cash flow management as good governance and policies to ensure the future financial security of our parish. The Finance Councils will be providing a financial update in the lead-up to Giving Sunday.

One of the major parish projects over the next three years will be the restoration of our beautiful heritage church of St Joseph. We have now formed two committees for the restoration: the Steering Committee and the Fundraising Committee. I have been very impressed with the professionalism and enthusiasm of the parishioners on these committees. They have made a great commitment of their time and talents to provide advice to Fr Greg. I look forward to the advice, guidance and support of the whole parish community as we proceed.

I would like to take this opportunity to recognise all the volunteers who I have met over my time here at the parish. You are the quiet achievers of our parish. There have been so many, I cannot name you or thank you enough for all you have given and continue to give to our parish community.

As I look back over the past 12 months, I recall the three pillars of Surrender, Discipleship and Mission. I thank God that I have had the opportunity to surrender to God my talents and time. I thank Him that I have experienced a discipleship that has encouraged me in my walk with Jesus and I thank Him that I have been able to support our mission by providing our parish with the resources needed to make disciples.
